



PRESERVE, PROTECT, PREVENT!

Hudson residents have already expressed their concerns about major development in the Phase II area. But, are you aware that development could occur at our historic Village Green, which would forever compromise the aesthetics and integrity of our town center? The 2016 Merino Block Development proposed to move the historic 1825 Baldwin-Buss House (familarly known as the Merino House) and would have surrounded it with a parking lot and large three-story residential, commercial and retail buildings--dominating the view across our historic west Village Green! Plans similar to what was proposed in 2016 remain a threat. If the Baldwin-Buss House Foundation fails in its attempt to secure the entire property, development will likely occur, compromising the house and the vista of the Village Green forever.

If you don't want to risk this kind of development towering over our Village Green and if you want to protect what differentiates Hudson from neighboring cities, support the Baldwin-Buss House Foundation in its efforts to purchase the historic house, adjacent land and existing commercial buildings. It is the intent of the Foundation to restore the house's historic, 1825 architectural integrity and create a center for arts, education and community events.
